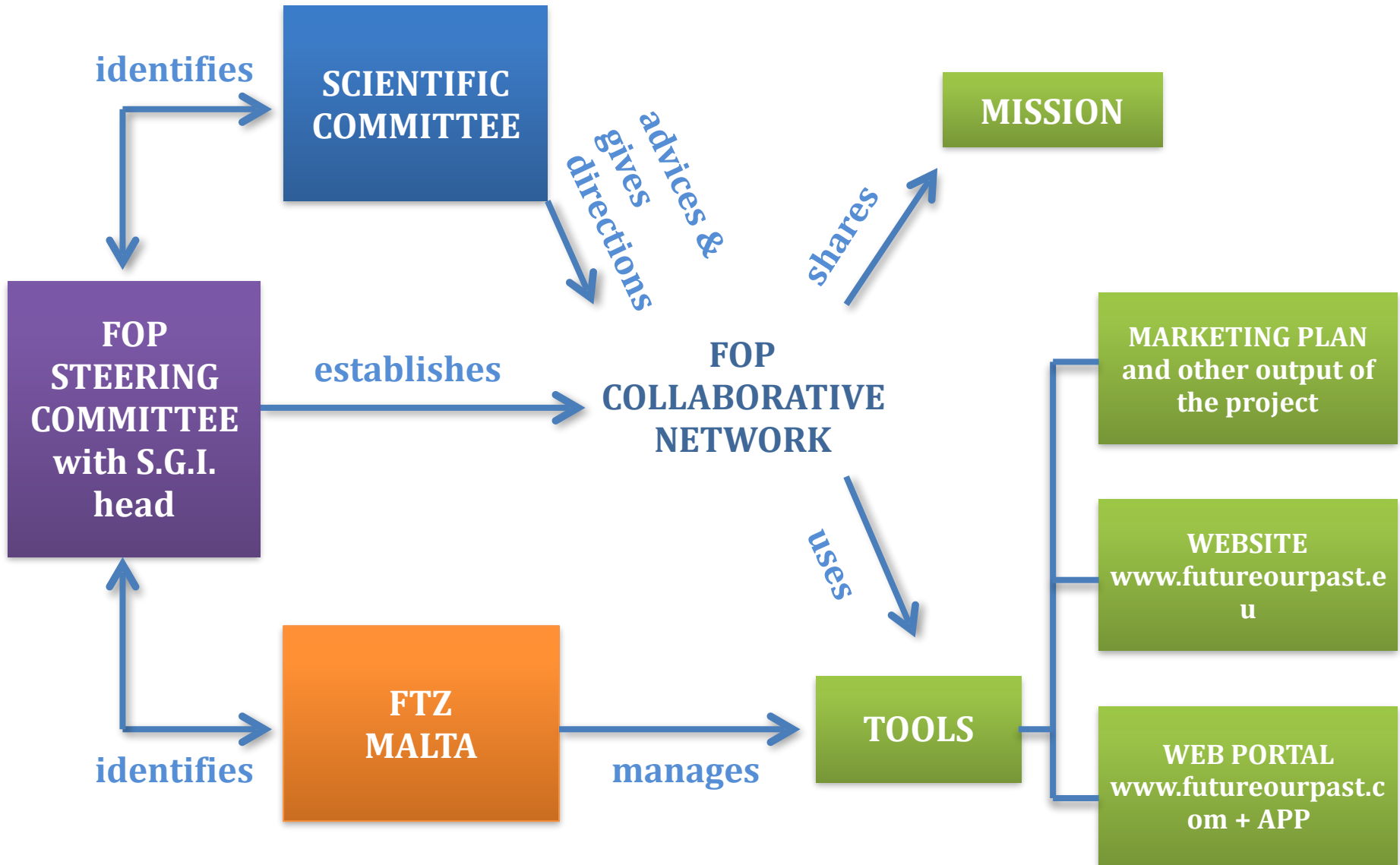

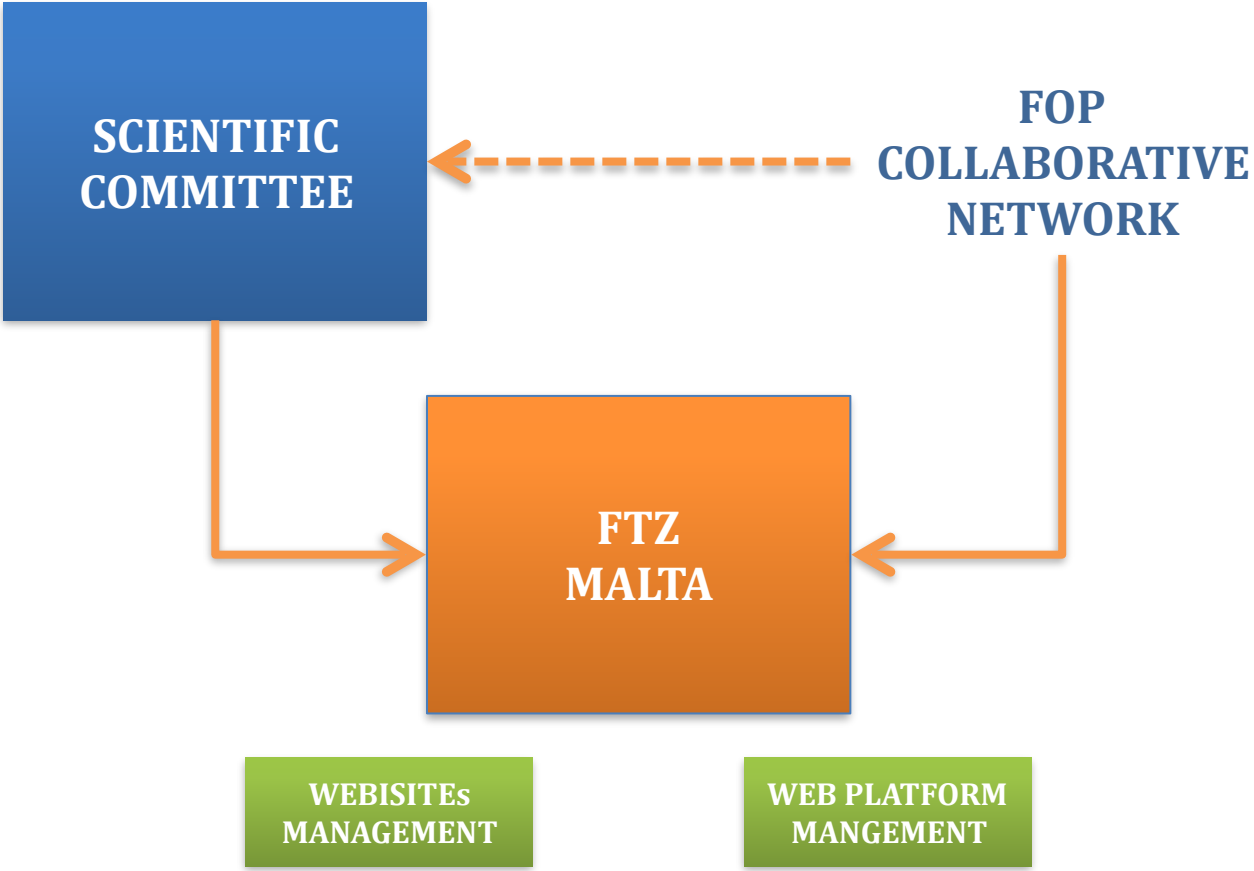

# TIMELINE OF ACTIONS

The main and the most important organism in FOP project is FOP Steering Committee with the head of S.G.I.

FOP Steering Committee establishes Scientific Committee to continue activities after project and appoints it to give advices and directions to FOP Collaborative Network.

Scientific Committee shares the FOP mission and uses it to manage Collaborative Network. Also, it coordinates FTZ Malta activities.

On the same time FOP Steering Committee establishes FOP Collaborative Network. It shares the FOP mission and uses FOP tools:

# MISSION of the network

*Future of Our Past project* aims to generate *innovative and sustainable tourism strategies*, in order to enhance the promotion of the extraordinary cultural and environmental heritage in the Mediterranean Basin, consisting of fascinating historical centers situated in the inner territories - rich in art, culture and tradition – that have rarely benefited from the tourist development, conversely focused on coastal areas. Creating a Mediterranean collaborative network among cross-border local communities and heterogeneous tourism stakeholders means:

- ***sharing within the cluster*** the best practices and resources achieved by the management of the historical centers;
- ***enhancing the set of skills and knowledge*** based on sustainable tourism to implement the training of transnational actors and policy makers;
- ***smooth developing of the networking international chain*** to attract further Mediterranean cities and tourism stakeholders;
- ***coordinating joint initiatives*** for the promotion of cultural events and ***dissemination activities*** to spread the latest touristic offers and packages;
- ***raising of the popular awareness*** for the conscious use of the local communities' s cultural heritage and for a sustainable mobility of visitors and residents.
